Did you know there were 4000 people in attendance at the show?






The show was great this year, although the aero engine guys from the air museum didn't bring along their merlin because of the weather, however there was plenty to see on show with all marques of British vehicles.

The NMCSA financial year runs from 1st July to 30th June.

Please renew your Club Membership prior to 1st JULY.

Log Books must be validated by 1st JULY every year by one of our

Club Registration Officers to remain valid & current.

The July meeting is usually our AGM & Log Books will <u>not</u> be validated.

Log Books can be validated at all other meetings if a Club Registrar is present.

Many members prefer Post, a self addressed & stamped envelope is required.

Log Book replacements cost \$5. Your old Log Book <u>must</u> be presented at this time.

If your membership is not paid by 1st JULY, your Club Registration & Log Book are no longer valid and you are riding unregistered.

The Club is required to notify the Department of Infrastructure and Transport of Logbook holders whose Membership is more than 2 months in arrears.

Which will result in your club registration being cancelled by DIT.
